#### Faith Formation/Youth Ministry

Many families have not yet submitted their registration forms. If you have a child in Grades 1 through 11, and would like them to participate in this year's program, please submit your registration by mail or drop off on or before August 28 (Parish Office is closed on Friday). If you would like to place it in the collection basket at next week's Mass, you may do so.

First Grade is the appropriate time to begin a child's formal instruction in their Catholic Faith. This will lay a firm foundation for their sacramental preparation for Reconciliation and Eucharist when they are in Second Grade. Regular attendance at weekly Mass is also an indispensable component of a child's preparation for receiving these sacraments and for their lived Faith experience throughout life.

The **Parent Handbook** and calendar for Faith Formation will be distributed to the children at the first class Monday – October 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Youth Ministry Calendar will be posted on our website by late August.
