Recycling Reminder ~ while we appreciate your donations of bottle & cans for deposits, we would appreciate it if you would rinse all containers before bringing them to church. Please remember people are handling these (we remove tabs for further recycling) and some of the bottles & cans are quite dirty & sticky. Unrinsed containers also attract ants and other pests. All proceeds from these containers go toward our monthly sandwich making supplies. In 2015, we collected \$293.30 toward this expense (that is a total of **5,866** bottles & cans!!).
