Deadline registration for the Faith Formation program is August 14. Many families have not yet submitted their registration forms. If you have a child in Grades 1 through 5 and would like them to participate in this year's program, please submit your registration by mail or drop-off on or before August 13 (Parish Office is closed on Friday). If you would like to place it in the collection basket at next week's Mass, you may do so.

First Grade is the appropriate time to begin a child's formal instruction in their Catholic Faith. This will lay a firm foundation for their sacramental preparation for Reconciliation and Eucharist when they are in Second Grade. Regular attendance at weekly Mass is also an indispensable component of a child's preparation for receiving these sacraments and for their lived Faith experience throughout life.

CHANGE: In response to the suggestion of parents, Class will be held on Monday afternoons from 4:00 to 5:00 PM. Many families were concerned about the children arriving late for class due to the school bus drop off and the ride to the Parish Center. It is our hope that this will afford the child an opportunity to arrive home, use the bathroom and perhaps grab a snack and be transported to class in a timely manner.
