2015 BISHOP'S APPEAL UPDATE: We have received 260 Pledges and/or Gifts totaling \$66,643 toward our \$71,268 Assessment Goal. These pledges/gifts represent almost 94% of our goal (we are so close!). Also interesting to note, our average gift here at St. Joseph's calculates to be \$256. A recent memo from the Stewardship Office advises that Diocesan-wide, the overall average gift is \$247 ~ congratulations on being "above average"! It is our hope to reach our Assessment Goal before the deadline of March 2016.
