

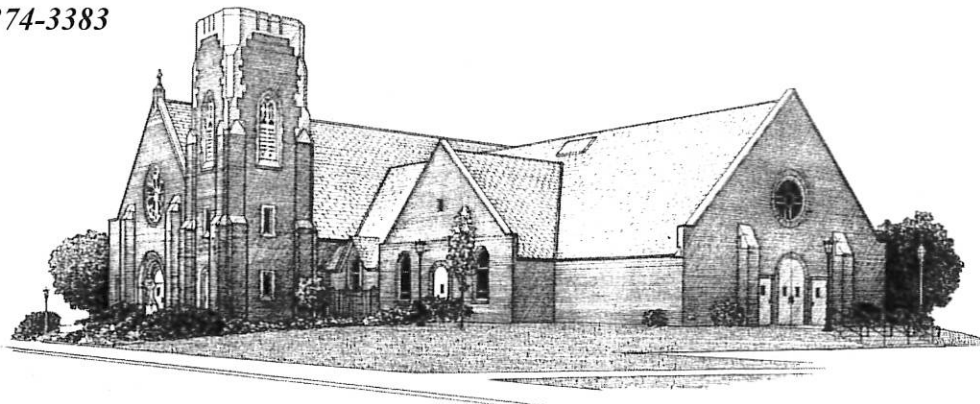

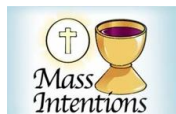


Financial News: Parish Income (all sources) for the period **May 24th-30th** amounted to **\$5,507.62**.
